Dear Prayer Warriors and Faithful Supporters,

Thank you all so much for your continued prayers. So much is happening in the ministry at Solid Rock Baptist Church. The Sunday School and church ministry continue to grow. We have added a Wednesday night Bible study. Friday Night Youth Club is an exciting time for our young people where they come to learn about God's Word and just have a fun time. I have had the privilege of teaching the books of the Bible during Friday Youth Club. It is always exciting to hear the kids singing a song they learned or talking about a lesson they heard in Sunday school or Friday Youth.

We are not only seeing growth in the church, but we have also had the opportunity to be involved in outreach into the community. Every Sunday, our church holds a service at a local homeless shelter. It is such a blessing to see our church people getting involved in this ministry. In April, we were able to hold a Holiday Club (much like a VBS) for 2 days in the Xhosa community. We spent an hour each day singing, playing games, and telling a Bible lesson. We had around 50-75 children in attendance and both days the Gospel was presented in the Xhosa language. In May, our church was involved in two community outreaches. We had our first medical outreach, which included checking blood pressures and blood sugars, giving educational handouts, and the Gospel. We also were able to have a soup kitchen which included singing, sharing a Bible lesson, and giving each child a meal (we are hoping to make this a regular ministry). We as a church also had the opportunity to deliver 60 care packages to mothers at a local hospital for a special Mother's Day event.

In my last prayer letter, I was still waiting for a reply from the South African Nursing Council. Praise the Lord, I have finally received approval to take my exams in November to become certified. I ask that you please continue to pray as I need to figure out how best to study for this exam.

I was able to complete my American Heart Association CPR Instructor Certification and am now able to teach classes. Thank you to all who have contributed towards the cost of classes and books for students to be able to take this class. I currently have funding enough for 60 students to complete the course. Praise the Lord!!! My hope is that I can offer these classes at little or no cost to the student, while also using it as a tool to reach people with the Gospel of Christ. It will cost approximately \$20 USD for the books for each student. **If you would like more information about sponsoring a student or an entire class, please contact me via email: h.bennett@dbmi.org.**

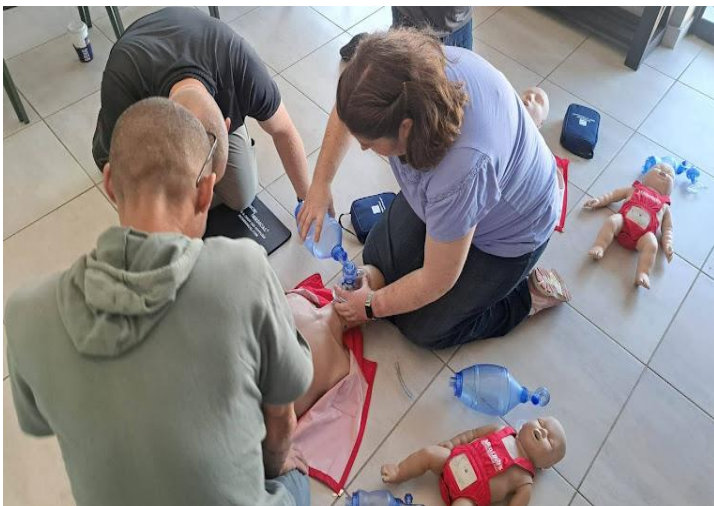
