As an added bonus, the health inspector came unannounced to our first day of café. She was very supportive of what we're doing and how much care we spent in professional food hygiene training. She gave us a 5 out of 5 hygiene rating, which is what restaurants like to proudly display in their windows. One more praise related to this: two supermarkets in the area responded to our emails requesting donations for café food and donated about \$80 in cash and gift card value.
