Besides teaching the small children on Sundays, my wife teaches a young ladies' class. She challenges the young ladies to separate themselves from the world. Our soul winners loaded up and invaded the evacuation camp with the Gospel. Hallelujah! We started the Gospel Kids' Club, as well as tried to saturate that camp with the Gospel. Ever since then, there have been hindrances to the people from the camp being able to come to church—everything from a medical lockdown, to rumors that we were trying to kidnap children, to the officials telling us that they just were not allowed to leave. When we heard that, we armed ourselves with God's Word and the country's constitution showing that they could not prohibit the freedom of worship. *"My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge . . ."* (Hosea 4:6)

Please be in prayer for the evacuees. Pray that God would remove the hindrances and that the people would come to church. Pray that God would divinely lead us in finding the other camps. Pray for God's power, protection, and provision for His work.

Praise the Lord that God has provided us with an extra ministry vehicle that has already been used to transport our missionary to Pakistan, who is staying with us for a short time. The ministry vehicle has been used to transport soul winners to win souls for Christ, and the vehicle has been used to bring folks to church. To God be all the glory! The Lord Jesus is coming very soon; let us be found faithful to Him. Like what one of our young men recently said, "I'm not looking for a 'mother ship'; I'm looking for the FATHER ship." Amen! Even so, come, Lord Jesus. Amen!
