- Teaching the Bible to Children enjoyed a strong online response with 42 students. Alongside of our students in Alberta, we had students from other Canadian provinces, the US, South Africa, Poland, Singapore, the Philippines, and Myanmar.

- We are offering a new class—Preparation for Ordination—with a goal of helping mature men transition into ministry. We limited the class to a cohort of 10, and the class is already nearly full.
- Our other classes include a Elementary Greek II, The Big Picture Story of Scripture, and Anchored Hearts: the Christian View of Emotions. We will also offer two asynchronous online courses—New Testament Theology, and The Great Questions of Christianity.
- The most remarkable progress for Foundation is the completed application process for accreditation. Cost has been the biggest barrier to moving forward. The board set a goal of raising the first 3-4 years of fees. This December we were amazed and delighted to receive the full funding and all of it from supporters within Alberta. This allowed us to formally file to begin the process last month.
