Dear Partners in the Ministry,

As we approach four years of life and ministry here in Ecuador, we are very thankful for what God has done! There have been many ups and downs and several challenging times, but through it all, God has been good and has allowed us to accomplish some of our goals during these first four years.

We had the opportunity to start Iglesia Bautista Libertad at the beginning of 2022 and have seen it grow to over 100 people. Through the generosity of many churches and individuals, we were able to purchase a piece of property and construct a permanent home for the church. We've also had the privilege of raising up a national pastor, Marcelo, who has been a great blessing to us and to the church.

I would like to thank everyone who has been part of our journey. I truly believe that our work here over the past four years has brought hope to North Quito and Calderón—the area where we serve—and that many people have been able to hear about Jesus, find a church home, and grow in their faith! With that being said, I wanted to share two exciting developments in our ministry:

1. Project Hope

We are thrilled to announce Project Hope! The focus of this project is to start another church in North Quito in 2027. From our experience in starting Iglesia Bautista Libertad, we have learned the importance of careful planning and proper funding for the success of a new church plant. Our heart is to start another local church in a different part of Quito so that more people can find hope in Jesus. We will need to raise \$150,000 to cover setup expenses, the first two years of church operations, and the purchase of a property for a long-term home for the new church.
