God brings at least one new visitor each Sunday, and some become regular attenders. A man we have known for a few years has always attended a Lutheran church, and began coming to our church in November. He eventually told us that he wants to be baptized because of what he read in Scripture, but the Lutheran church will not baptize him since he was confirmed as a child. Branden has been teaching him about salvation and biblical baptism, and he is grateful and excited that finally someone is willing to explain the Scripture to him.
