On the 22<sup>nd</sup>, we were back in North Carolina to update two of our supporting churches in Lexington and Salisbury. We enjoyed some fellowship with both churches over that weekend. Stacy was also able to meet pastor Pedro Palma of the seminary in Chile for the first time face-to-face. Since both were within an hour of each other, they met for breakfast in North Carolina. In addition to the regular seminary options, they may expand to offer a clearinghouse or mission agency for national Hispanic missionaries. Please pray for God's direction.

Gospel Light has called Caleb Waycaster to be their new pastor. We pray that the transition will go smoothly, and the Lord's will be accomplished.

The only thing left undone was to get a primary care physician set up for Stacy and a neurologist appointment for Jennifer.
