We held our first Bible doctrines and ethics conference with Dr. Mike Bere. We reconnected with him last year when we participated in the 50th anniversary events of Pensacola Christian College. It was an honor to have our college professor and mentor with us in Peru, and the practical teachings were a blessing not only to our church people, but also to the other churches that participated. We have already scheduled the next conference for next year.
