Dear Praying Friends,

Praise the Lord! God has done it again! We prayed very hard for God to grant a visa for my wife to make it to the States. Well, God came through again in His perfect time. In May, Japhia was approved for a visa, and we immediately booked our tickets to the States. By God's grace, we arrived in the US for our Mission's Candidate School. I am reminded of Mark 7:37, "And were beyond measure astonished, saying, He hath done all things well..." We thank the Lord for His grace and perfect timing for everything.

VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL – We just finished up Vacation Bible School at the church in Cebu, and saw 127 children accept Christ as Savior, as well as over a dozen parents! For hundreds of these precious kids, it was their first time to experience a "Bounce House," but most importantly, they were able to experience an environment where they could see and feel firsthand the Love of the Lord. One of the goals in every VBS is that these precious souls would know how much God loves them, and how much we love them at the church.

FURLOUGH – We are currently stateside for a furlough, which will be a perfect time to work on my wife's paperwork, and for her to go through a One Year Bible course at Westcoast Baptist College. Please, pray for her as she will pursue her Bible college study online. Pray also for God's provision for it. My wife is overjoyed to be here in the US and minister to those we come in contact with. We still have openings for 2025, and praying for wisdom of where we need to be in the will of God during this furlough. I do ask you to pray for us as we are on furlough for safety traveling and more grace for a long journey. God's grace is sufficient, so we are leaning on Him.

CEBU CHURCH PLANT – The work back in Cebu City is being held down by three of our trained men. I would like for you to pray personally for these men and their wives as they lead and serve the Lord in our absence at the Cebu church. Pray for Azer and Alexis, Warren and Angelie, and Jim and Janelle. We also have two other men named Sam and Jundy who are preaching as well. I am humbly asking that you pray for them specifically, bringing their names to the Lord in prayer. One of the greatest burdens for a missionary on furlough is that the enemy would come in and attack what the Lord has done. However, we are going to cover them in prayer and trust the Lord to protect and grow His work and bind the enemy.
