Dear Praying Brothers and Sisters,

November 5, 2025

Thank you so much for your earnest prayers for peace. God mercifully allowed the attack from the other villages to unite Sagifa. No one else has died as far as we know, and things are cooling down. Please pray specifically for Laita, who has been out of church and not walking with God during the fighting. He was panning for gold on the land of the people who were murdered when his hole collapsed and he was buried up to his neck. In God's mercy, he survived. Please pray he comes back to the Lord.

God graciously allowed us to surpass our goal of 10,000 students per week in the Bible Clubs this year. God blessed our training last week for the Bible Clubs at the national pastors' conference. The clubs are moving forward effectively as pastors pick one school within walking distance of their church. We have also set up the logistics for curriculum distribution in a couple of key locations across the country. As we look towards next year, it is crucial that we have staff members in key centers to facilitate the volunteers who are teaching. We are trying to reach 25,000 students a week. It costs a little over \$1.20 a student per month to facilitate curriculum and training. God has graciously provided \$265,352 for next year's budget already, but we still need \$95,767.

One great joy in the Bible Club ministry is seeing the growth in our lives personally and the lives of our staff. I believe we have tasted the Lord's work of revival in our lives and the lives of those around us. Thank you so much to our 6 prayer warriors in the USA who fast for us each week as they are able, and our four prayer warriors in PNG. One of the prayer warriors told me his favorite part of the ministry is the times of fasting and prayer.

We will be finding prayer warriors for next year if any of you would like to join us in prayer. The areas that can be picked from are Revival, curriculum, funding, training, health, and logistics.

As some of you knew, we had unresolved issues with the new Epson printer that made it impossible to use the finisher equipment, and it would only shoot paper out of the side of the unit. This meant someone had to sit next to the machine and take paper off as it printed. Today, praise God, three service techs working together for free over Zoom helped us get it figured out, and those issues are fixed!

These have been the happiest years of ministry for us, but also the most challenging. We are planning to leave for the States on November 16<sup>th</sup> and return on January 14<sup>th</sup> for a short break.

Although we already have meetings scheduled, we hope to have time to pray, rest, and see our family before we hit the ground running when school starts back in PNG early next year. Thank you so much for being the best team of supporters ever.
