

A Year in Review

We are so thankful for all that God did during 2024. Lori and I want to thank you for faithfully praying and giving sacrificially to make the ministry in Chile possible. Here are a few highlights from this past year:

- 1. We officially constituted one church and ordained one pastor.
- 2. More than a dozen local churches partnered together to distribute more than 300,000 gospel tracts throughout Chile.
- 3. The Chile Baptist College enrolled 114 students from 4 different countries, and 14 students graduated from our programs. (Pictured: one of our graduates alongside two of our teachers.)
- 4. We hosted 7 camps, conferences, and retreats throughout the year, serving hundreds from the local Chilean churches.
- 5. Six groups from supporting churches in the USA visited the ministry.
- 6. Partnering with Medical Mission Outreach, we witnessed more professions of faith in a single week than any other since we've been in Chile.
- Lori and I both taught classes at the Chile Baptist College. I also taught missions classes at the Vision School of Missions.
- 8. One of our Bible college students joined missionary Stephen Carrier in planting a new church near downtown Santiago.
- 9. God allowed me to speak at 20 different churches in 3 different countries.
- 10. Special projects made possible by your support include: (1) the purchase of land for Trinity Baptist; (2) a large metal structure at the Bible college, now serving as our 'chapel'; and (3) a fully furnished recording studio at the Bible college.

Finishing a Stage of Parenthood

During the final weeks of 2024, Lori and I traveled to the USA to help Andrew transition into this next chapter of his life. He turned 18 on January 4th and will now continue his studies and work in the States. Despite his young age, Andrew has already completed high school, advanced through two years of Bible college studies with Veritas Baptist College, and launched an online business, Talknova, offering Spanish tutoring for those wanting to learn the language.

As our youngest child leaves the nest and steps into adulthood, Lori and I could not be prouder. Born in Chile, Andrew grew up witnessing God's work on the mission field.
