

## **Trusting God in Tragedy and Recovery**

On Father's Day evening, our youngest son, Andrew, fell off an electric scooter and sustained three skull fractures, a traumatic brain injury, a severe concussion, and dislodged two bones in his middle ear, resulting in significant hearing loss. Within hours, thanks to social media, hundreds, if not thousands, of people across the U.S. and around the world began praying for him. In the midst of fear and uncertainty, we experienced the peace of God that surpasses all understanding. While in the ICU, Andrew was closely monitored. By God's grace, the doctors determined that brain surgery was not necessary. They initially estimated a 4–8 week recovery period before he could drive, return to work, and resume normal activities. To everyone's amazement, just ten days after the accident, Andrew passed a physical therapy stress test and was cleared to begin resuming all activities gradually. There's no other explanation but God. To Him be the glory! Please continue to pray for the restoration of his hearing. He will meet with specialists in July to determine what further treatment may be needed.
