## **Every Door in '24**

Of the approximately 10,000 doors in Fluvanna, about 8,600 have now received a marked John/Romans and a church flyer inviting them to FBBC. Many of the remaining houses are in the gated community of Lake Monticello, and they will be receiving postcards in these last remaining weeks of 2024. Those houses already received copies of John/Romans when we had access to the community. We also visited a lady this past month who had received her own copy of John/Romans and wanted a dozen more to give to her grandchildren for Christmas. Of course, we were happy to help!

## **FBBC Events**

On the Sunday before Thanksgiving Day, we had a Pie and Praise testimony service. The Lord sent us a visitor that night who had received his invitation to visit six months earlier. We were encouraged to realize that we might be reaping from our sowing efforts for many months to come.

We had two special speakers, Chris Tignor, missionary to Ecuador, and Pastor Dan MacAvoy, in the last few weeks and were encouraged by good preaching and fellowship. On December 15, we will be having a Candlelight and Carols service, with our kids' class singing several specials. Please pray with us for visitors to attend as the gospel will be clearly presented.

## A Possible New Location

Our Sunday services have been held at the local high school since we started morning services in May of 2023. The high school is centrally located in the county and is located on Route 53, which is well-traveled. However, when we went to renew our contract with the school board for the upcoming year, we were informed that the price would increase \$461 a month even though we were not renting any additional hours.



We had seen a building farther south on route 15 earlier in the year, but hadn't looked into it. After hearing about the rate increase, Scot stopped by one day, and the caretaker just



"happened" to be there and let him look at the property. It has three large rooms and one smaller available, split into two suites. We would be able to rent half of the space for only ten dollars more than we are currently paying for the school. Plus, we would have the benefit of having the space 24/7 rather than for only five hours on Sunday every week. As of now, after seeking counsel from our sending pastor and others, we are hoping to

sign a lease on the property this coming week. On Sunday, December 8, we presented the opportunity to the congregation and they were excited about the possibility of a permanent space in which to meet. Please pray for the Lord's will in this matter to be clear.

We so appreciate your prayers for the growth of Foundations Bible Baptist Church and for our family as we seek to reach Fluvanna county with the gospel.
