We have a map displayed at our church services, and it has been exciting to see that the eastern portion of the county has now been reached, either by mailings or door-to-door visitation. Please pray as we continue in our effort to get the gospel into the more remote places in this rural county, for the Word to bear fruit.

June happenings

On June 15, a teen group from Temple Baptist in Dulles, Virginia, joined us for a short missions trip to see a church plant. Youth pastor Scott Devane and his wife brought eleven teens, who helped us to deliver gospel packets on Saturday. We were thankful for so many willing hands and feet, particularly in the hot summer, who delivered over 650 packets.

On Sunday, they arrived early and helped us with setting up for the church services and served as greeters. We were blessed with the





teens' special music, and Bro. Devane preached for our Sunday school and morning service. Then, they helped us with packing up after the church service. In all, they were a big encouragement and a blessing!

A family that had been saved earlier in the year moved back to Buffalo, New York, right after the school year. We were delighted to get to see them one more time as they returned to Virginia for the last load of belongings in June. William and Ava both followed the Lord in baptism this last Sunday, and we are praying

for them to become active and faithful in the church there in New York. We had a good conversation with Rich during the visit and are praying that he, too, will be saved.

In addition to continued mailings and door-to-door work, plans for outreach in August through October include hosting a booth at the county fair from August 15-17. Please pray with us for wisdom to prepare, for the right location for our booth, and for opportunities to witness and make connections with people as we pass out water and gospel literature.

On September 14, we will be setting up our church booth at Fork Union Day. This will be the first time for us to attend this event. As Fork Union is several miles south of Palmyra, we are hoping to meet more contacts from the southern portion of the county where we have been focusing our door-to-door visitation in these last few months.

Then on October 19 we are planning a Day at the Park for families, with a Bible lesson, crafts, and games. Invites for this event will be included in door-to-door packets, handed out at the fair and at Fork Union Day, as well as advertisements put in the local paper and on social media. Please pray with us as we prepare, for wisdom and then for a good turnout from the community.
