Dear Pastors and praying friends,

She connected with a 'local' (two hours away is pretty close for us) pastor's wife that has had a work in Columbia Falls for over 30 years. I had met the pastor once at the Passage, as well. They were having a revival that we were able to attend, and that, too, was a great encouragement to us.

I wanted to get into Browning this spring and begin to start something there. Browning is the seat of the Blackfeet nation. The people I thought were excited about having us start something there have kind of lost interest for now. Like Cut Bank, the Lord must build His Church. We ask that you would pray for Browning as you have prayed for Cut Bank. The Lord is working.

Our Mongolian foreign exchange student, Misheel, will be leaving us at the end of the month after the high school graduation. We have prayed and explained the Gospel many times. Please be praying that the Lord will give her understanding and draw her unto Himself.

Ja-el is also graduating at the end of the month. Please pray that God would direct and guide her as she seeks His will for her life.

Please continue to pray for our church and our summer outreach. We are planning a VBS in July, and a men's campout soon. We thank you for your faithful prayers and know that this fruit will abound to your account.
