Dear faithful ministry partner,





The church in Kouentou had their first baptism service, baptizing fourteen people! One of those that got baptized was a woman named Doubaya Sanou. She is a 70 year old widow and a little fireball. When she got saved, she faced extreme opposition from some in the village. They cut off all financial support and told her that she would receive no help again until she renounced Christ. But Doubaya stood firm in her faith and refused to abandon Christ. She has become one of our most faithful members at the church and the church has been able to step in and help her when the others forsook her. Her faith and testimony have become a bright light in the village When she got baptized, the entire church broke out in a huge applause! Please continue to pray for Doubaya and the others who were baptized, that God will continue to work in their lives.

For Christmas this year, our churches tried something new! With help from Taking the Light, we put together a Bible trivia game show for the community called Bobo Quiz Biblique. During the month of November, we had participants take part in games and activities at the church. The 24


