A few minutes later, his wife stopped by our booth. As we talked, she mentioned that her husband used to run a print shop. I asked her if she could get him to return to our booth, which she did. I found out that our new Messianic Jew friend had worked at his shop with much of the same equipment that we have. When asked if he would help us in our shop, he said he would gladly help however he could. We needed some help, so this was a direct answer to prayer. That same evening, I came across a new church booth as I walked around the fair, talking to vendors. In the past several years, we have been the only gospel booth there. I stopped to let them know how good it was to see someone else reaching people with the message of God's salvation. As we talked and shared stories of God's provision, I mentioned that we had a print shop and explained some of our immediate equipment needs. He perked up when he heard we had a print shop and told me he owned one in Portland. Then he said he had a cutter they were not using anymore and that we could have it if we wanted. Wow! Praise the Lord! I have found over the years that if I am faithful to labor in God's field, He will meet my needs by directing my steps and placing me in the right place at the right time. He guides us as we labor. We know as we go.

Thank you for your continued prayers for our print shop renovation project. We have completed most of the major structural repairs to the main building. This coming year, we are emphasizing our John & Romans Seedline and gospel tract printing ministries by having many more church-related projects and events. Our church loves both ministries, but we need more laborers. Please pray that God will raise more laborers as we seek to spread His word in New England and around the world.

Our Master Clubs children's program and our Homeschool Support Group are both going well and have been well attended. Most of the children, if not all, in our Master Clubs are lost. Some of them have been asking a lot of questions. Please pray that they will understand and respond to the gospel by repenting and believing on Christ Jesus.

I look forward to continuing our partnership to reach New England with the glorious gospel of our Lord and Savior in the coming year.
