Dear Praying Friends,

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

In April, my family and I traveled three and a half hours north to Hope Bible Baptist Church in Whiting, ME, where Brother Bo Redmon is pastor. I had the privilege of preaching at their revival meeting this year. I don't know of a meeting I have enjoyed more. The people had such a sweet spirit and were attentive to the Word. God is doing great things in Whiting, ME, and I know the Redmon Family and the church would appreciate your prayers.

We held our revival meeting at Royal River Baptist Church in May. Pastor Davy Shelton preached, and the Scott Agee family provided the special music. We were all greatly encouraged and challenged, and although no one was saved, several of the lost who have been attending our services were challenged in particular ways.

At the end of May, our church hosted a Rock of Ages Prison Ministry Training taught by our missionary Brother Matthew Frank. Several of our men were able to attend the training and then participated in a Rock of Ages Prison Revival in Berlin, NH. God worked in their hearts, and they desire to be more involved in the prison ministry.

The Lord continues to bless and meet the needs of our printing ministry, Royal River Baptist Press. We recently received another significant donation for the ministry that will help us continue renovating the building and secure some minor equipment and furnishings. We want to purchase two larger pieces of equipment: a Duplo Crease/Slitter/Cutter and a Duplo System 5000 Saddle Stitcher. We are currently in discussions with a company based out of NC concerning purchasing these two pieces of equipment. They are searching for an integrated folding system for the cutter. The Duplo machine with the integrated folding system would significantly increase our quality and productivity and would reduce the manpower we need to produce gospel tracts and brochures. The stitcher would allow us to collate, stitch, and finish 5,000 John and Romans scripture portions per hour. Both pieces are needed to make the print shop more efficient and cost-effective.

On a personal note, our son Philip is graduating from High School this year. We are very proud of the man he is becoming. Please pray that God will direct his steps as he seeks direction about his future.

Pete, the young man who was recently saved, is doing well. He has been meeting with me for discipleship and has helped with maintenance around the print shop. Please pray for his continued spiritual growth and the salvation of his lost family and friends.

The gentleman who brought Pete to church was also recently saved. He said that after coming to church and sitting under the preaching, he realized that he did not have a specific time and place in his life when he could point to being born again. So, he trusted the Lord for salvation and now has assurance and peace. I had the privilege of baptizing Mike and Pete on the first Sunday in June. Praise the Lord! There is still victory in Jesus!

As always, thank you for your consistent prayers, encouragement, and faithful financial support. We cannot express just how thankful we are for all of you. You are making an eternal difference!
